Children of members of the Vacaville Noon Rotary Club are not eligible to apply for any Rotary Scholarships.

The amount of the scholarship will be as follows:
\$1,500.00

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a student who has served on the school newspaper in the capacity of either a writer or photographer or is also planning on pursuing a degree in Journalism or photojournalism.
2. Graduating senior with a GPA no lower than 3.5 who will be attending a four-year accredited university.
3. Letters of recommendation from two schoolteachers or administrators.
4. Letters of recommendation from two members of the community (cannot be a relative).
5. A one page typed letter from the applicant on why he or she is deserving of this scholarship.
6. Copy of school transcript.
7. List of all extra curricular activities.
8. Photograph of all applicants.
9. Please include a cover page with name, address, phone numbers, e-mail addresses and parents names.

QUESTIONS TO BE ANSWERED BY APPLICANT:

1. In what way have you made a positive impact or affected change at your school since you enrolled?

2. What is your knowledge of Rotary and its accomplishments in the world and in your community?

3. What are your plans after graduating from high school?

4. Who has been the most influential person in your life and why?

5. What is your most enjoyable memory of high school?

6. Please share your knowledge of John Rico and his contributions to the city of Vacaville.

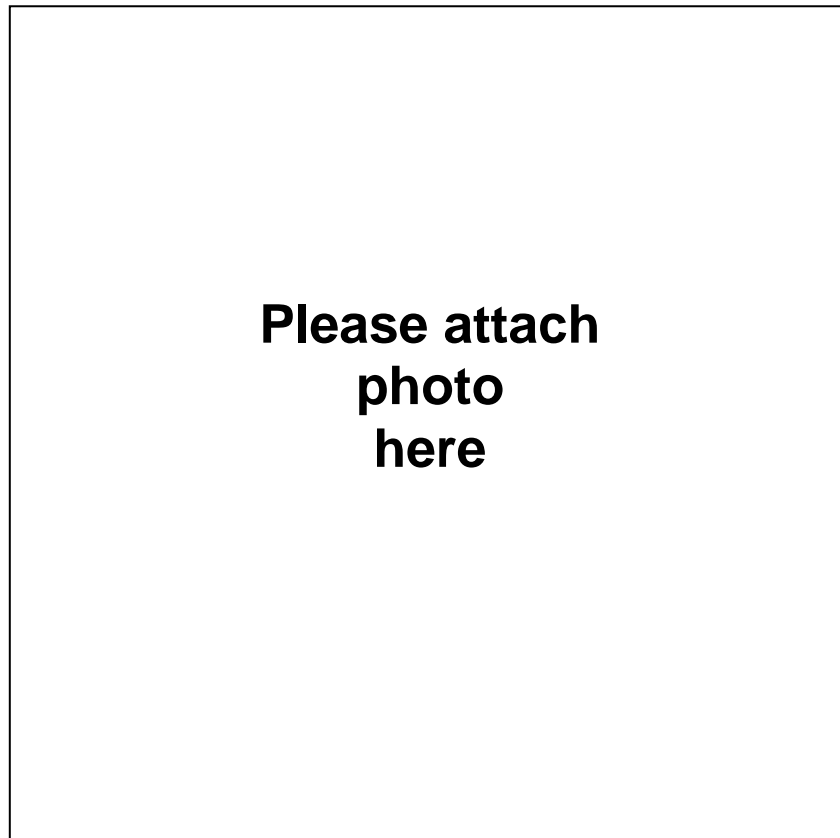
